Brixton Ice Rink Project



Coming soon... a 26m x 56m ice rink with associated changing areas and spectator facilities to ensure continuity of ice skating provision during the redevelopment of Streatham Ice Rink.

What about the building?

The structure itself is re-locatable (so that we can remove it quickly when the Streatham Hub opens...) and will be clad with insulated wall panels to ensure ice users have a controlled skating environment, whilst the roof system includes acoustic material to help reduce the impact of noise on surrounding properties.

...and what about the ice...?

The ice bed is being provided by one of the world's most specialised ice suppliers, Ice-World of Holland who supply a number of temporary ice rinks around the UK.


More recently, they have supplied a 5Km long temporary ice track for a distance skating event and an ice hockey arena for a series of events in New Zealand.

...how about sustainability...?


The chillers and heat pump units being installed for the ice rink are all high efficiency units which can be remotely monitored for key performance elements, ensuring they run at maximum efficiency throughout.

The steel building, the ice pad and chillers will all be re-located following use in Brixton, reducing our impact on the environment.
